WHEN TO USE A OR AN



To play Connect Four: “A” or “An”, you’ll need a Connect Four grid and a set of coloured counters for each player. The youngest player goes first. On your turn, choose a word from the grid and place your counter on it. Then, say whether you would use “a” or “an” before that word. Use “a” before words that begin with a consonant sound (e.g., a dog, a book), and use “an” before words that start with a vowel sound (e.g., an apple, an idea). If your answer is wrong, remove your counter. The first player to connect four counters in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally – with the correct article choice wins! with the correct type of words wins!!
